Greetings!

With this first edition of our newsletter we welcome you to join us in the adventure of learning to Walk more fully in the ways of our Messiah, Y'shua of Nazareth. Set Apart Ministries, Inc. is a non profit organization incorporated in January, 2000. Our mission statement is found in Hebrews 10: 32-39.

As we have sought to come alongside people who are coming out of extremely difficult, occultic or abusive lifestyles, we also learned that we needed to come out of the traditional church system as we studied Torah from a Messianic perspective.

In these past five years, as Y'shua is developing a Torah pursuant community here, we have learned a great deal about maturity in all areas of life. Our Messiah calls us to grow up in every way into Him Who is our Head. This can be an incredible challenge! Through speaking with others in Messianic communities around the country through Messianic Israel Alliance, we have found that a common experience is forming a community, only to have it break up over internal conflicts and inability to resolve concerns. A strong Biblical knowledge foundation is not always the same thing as having the maturity and skill in leading a community. Our calling is to come alongside the Body of Messiah and help develop the individual and corporate maturity that we will all need in the coming days.

We are now ready to share what we have learned with you from our professional perspective of five years in dealing with the challenges presented when re-aligning your life with Torah. We would also like to share our expertise in working with interpersonal relationship issues as well as conflict management: both a reflection of the maturity level of the individuals involved. Walking in Torah 101



As leaders within our previous church communities and trained Bible Study teachers, we have both walked through the first years of coming into Torah observance and supported others who are coming along. We have

observed that there are many common areas of concern and that, all too often, a person or a family who becomes convicted to observe Torah is too far away from others of like mind to develop a regular community. Since the concerns are so often similar, we will offer a series of observations and suggestions for coping in the following areas:

She is currently working on her Bachelors Degree in Messianic Studies and plans to complete

the decision to make major lifestyle changes often comes the need to talk out loud and express oneself...often repeatedly! about the whole experience. This initial introductory group will be free of charge and limited to the first 25 people who register. The long distance fee is covered by the caller and with a phone card, such as from Sam's Club at 3 cents a minute the fee can be as little as \$1.80 for the opportunity to speak with others of like mind.

Maturing in Messiah

In becoming Torah observant, we begin to learn new lifestyles that are foreign to us. By doing so, we also face opposition from family and friends. How do you react when faced with rejection or people telling you you're wrong--anger, explosive, defensive or just run away? And as we work to build Torah communities, what about all the relationship problems that develop?

One of our goals at Set Apart Ministries is to learn to walk the way Y'shua walked and to become the people He created us to be. Living in the world has caused us to have gaps in our maturing process and we don't always act the way we would want to, in a way that glorifies our Adonai (Romans 7:19). In the coming weeks, we will be discussing the concepts of growing up and maturing. The good news--through the work of Y'shua, we're not stuck!
