Our preference is to use the Hebrew Font but we have yet to be able to integrate this font into our website and this newsletter format. Efforts are underway. We did *not* know that using the transliteration Yahshua seems to bring some "baggage" along with it as it is associated with the groups who view it as the only acceptable way. We do not think that the transliteration preferred is the most important focus. Until we are able to incorporate the Hebrew font, we appreciate our readers understanding that we do not intend to be dogmatic on this issue in any way.

SNARK THAT SARK!



If you're like me, I sometimes think about what it must have been like to live in the Garden of Eden. What joy it must have been to live in a perfect environment, walking and talking with *Elohim!* Adam and Hava didn't know about murder, lust, abortion, stress, illness--all the things that plague us in our modern day lives. They did not know about evil. As long as they stayed away from the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and

Your feedback is most welcome! Where do you see yourself in this comparison?

As we prepare to schedule telephone follow up surveys with those who responded to our Messianic Leadership Concerns survey, we have met with an unexpected opportunity. Praise be to our Messiah!

Because we listed our survey request in Hebrew Roots newsletter, we have been contacted by Messianic Believers in several prison settings, requesting our materials and resources. One letter represented a group of about 60 Messianic Believers who are in need of encouragement, Scripture study materials and materials about the development of maturity.

We will respond to the request for support as well as we are able to do so and then will be giving prayerful consideration to what ongoing service we are to offer. It is certain that the concerns they face, both as individuals and as groups within the prison setting would be different from fellowships in communities in many ways.

We would like very much to respond to their requests and come alongside them in the process of maturing in our Messiah, though our financial resources are limited. Since they do not have access to online materials, we would like to send the following package to each prisoner or group:

1 Book Living From the Heart Jesus Gave You

1 Work book " " " "

Paper copies of our newsletters with maturity information

Paper copies of related articles from our website

It would appear that this would require approximately \$40 per each request for purchase, production and mailing. Where there is a group of Messianic Believers we would like to send a CD ROM Teaching on Maturity if they have access to the necessary equipment to make use of it. This would be an additional \$20 cost.

Would you be willing to stand with us and support these incarcerated Messianic Believers as they grow toward Maturity in our Messiah? We have received one set of book and workbook that we can send along so far.

We would appreciate financial donations toward this effort-- this one time provision of a set of materials --as well as printing and mailing costs on a monthly basis.

If you could provide the toner cartridge or printing service for

Evil, all was well.

Unfortunately, we all know the story. *Hashatan* tempted *Hava* with the fruit by appealing to her flesh, "You shall be like God." *There is a way which seems right to a man, But its end is the way of death (Prov. 14:12 NASB).*

Ever since that moment, with the bite of the fruit we have been in an endless battle with our flesh and our true heart in *Yahshua*. There is the struggle to understand what is **Truth** and what is **False**. The *Life Model* calls this the "sark." This word is based on the Greek word *sarx*, which *is the seat of false discernment, false guidance, and false knowledge of good and evil. (Page 110, Life Model, copyright 2000-R).*

In our bi-monthly group, we have people with a wonderful sense of humor. They began to make up a Dr. Suess-style poem called, "Snark that Sark!" It's funny, but it is also a good reminder! Don't let that flesh get in the way!

Daily, we hear people making decisions with their false understanding. An unwed pregnant teen with no place to go-- abortion is the answer. This "problem" would only complicate her life and

the articles, that would also go a long way toward meeting this request.

We will continue to pray for Yahshua's leading as we come alongside these brothers.

Well, we will be dealing with all that comes with relocating our office during the month of June. We appreciate your patience as we go through setting up telephone and internet service during this time. (If you have had trouble getting through to us by email please let us know using our 800 telephone number (866-634-0291).

We have just had a recent notice that this has happened again and we do not want to miss communicating with you.)

This move is part of Set Apart Ministries coming out from under the "wing" of Still Waters of Green Bay, Inc. my outpatient mental health clinic. As I continue to make the transition away from formal mental health services, a coming out of Egypt if you will, Still Waters is no longer able to subsidize Set Apart Ministries. This transition has been in the making and expected for some time, though how exactly it is to be accomplished is still not entirely clear. I appreciate your prayer cover during this time as well.

My thoughts parallel those of the psalmist and of Marty Goetz' song: *and though I'm slow of step and though my heart is filled with fears, still after all these years, this one thing I know: Unless it is the Lord Who builds the house, the watchmen watch in vain!*

Several of our SAM people are exercising their creative abilities and are pleased to be able to offer Tzittziot, challah covers, tallit and shofar bags, and various praise and moedim banners for your enjoyment and donations.

We even have a number of 6 foot long Tzit tzits for display!

We will be making them available to you at our June 18th presentation of First Fruits of Zion, Restoration! seminar by Toby Janicki. We also hope to have a table at the MIA conference in Nashville, where we will also be offering the Steps to Joy: Dance Worship training for Non Dancers DVD.

Our website will host a catalog for these and other items when we are able to set this up, hopefully by this summer. Plans are also in progress to do a video format teaching on how to tie tzit tzit. Watch for it sometime this summer as well.

Our little Set Apart community here in Green Bay requests your prayers and support as we continue our efforts to prepare for the Nashville MIA conference in July and, in fact, just as we live from day to day. Financial and health crisis have hit a

the child's. The best thing to do is get rid of the problem. It's called tolerance to accept homosexuality, after all they were born that way. Put old and sick people out of their misery with euthanasia. We don't want them to suffer unnecessarily.

For us as believers in the Torah of YHWH, those are easy answers. Without a doubt, we know they are **wrong** according to YHWH. It's simple to stand upon the correct answers in these situations. Then there are situations when it's not so clear.

When **we** begin to try to "figure out" what is the best solution, we immediately enter dangerous territory. Think of some situations when you thought you were doing the "right, sensible" thing and it turned out to be a disaster. A difficult area in which our "sark" can take over is in being a people helper. We don't like to see people struggle (parents, can you relate?). I had a relative who was very generous and loved her family. She indiscriminately gave money to her children and grandchildren. As a result, they never learned how to be financially responsible

number of our members.

Although we have covered the registration costs (in part thanks to generous donations) and have some money set aside toward travel expenses for the 20 people who are carpooling, the hotel expense for 7 rooms for 5 nights looks daunting just now. We are so appreciative of MIA's arrangements for half price rooms yet this still represents a major expense.

As you may know, only several members of our little community are gainfully employed. Many of our members are disabled and have bare minimum incomes, often having to make such choices as whether to buy groceries or pay for necessary medications. Several members of our group live next door to one another in low income housing and have become very good at carpooling, yet one of them has just lost her car as irreparable. She has no funds to replace it. The various problems that have arisen in the past few months have drained the resources of those on disability and limited the available funds for those who are employed to help. We are focusing on worship and joy in our Messiah for whatever provision He chooses to make, as well as taking whatever physical steps we can to address the concerns.

But What About Grace? Part II

GRACE DEFINED

In a secular context, people may think of grace as physical ability and ease of movement. People may also think in terms of social grace, as in charm and beauty. In a Biblical sense, however, we often think of grace as "unmerited favor." In our English Bibles, the word grace appears to have just this one meaning and that one has been presented most often as "unmerited favor." In truth, there are at least two Hebrew words that are translated into English as grace.

leaving in their wake pain, anger and frustration.

Jeremiah 17:9 says *the heart is more deceitful than all else and is desperately sick; who can understand it? (NASB)*

Did Jeremiah mean that the heart is always wrong; that we can *never* trust it? This is a warning to keep our hearts healthy. We must have hearts that know *Yahshua* and His *Torah*.

The three conditions of true knowing are these:
**

- Our hearts must be the healthy hearts that Jesus (*Yahshua*) gave us.
- Our hearts must be turned toward God with all our love and strength.
- We must weed out and avoid the words and judgments of the *sark*.

*The three conditions of false knowing are these:***

- We are listening to our own understanding (the *sark*).
- Our hearts are too sick, blind or deaf to discern God.
- Our hearts are not turned toward God

Chesed: the common understanding applies to this one: unmerited favor Strongs #2616/17

but are loving and listening to a different source.

Chen: the less understood related word meaning grace, beauty, charm, Strongs # 2580/81

The common understanding has been that grace is only evident in the Brit Chadasha/New Testament. Yet grace is evident through out the Tanakh/Old Testament and, in fact, is used more often than it is in the Brit Chadasha! Avi Ben Mordechai does a very thorough chapter on these concepts in his book: *Messiah, Understanding His Life and Teachings in Hebraic Context, Vol. 1.*

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight." (Prov. 3:5-6 NASB)

Personally, I was so excited to learn this following bit of information that clearly demonstrates YHWH's nature includes grace, by His own report, even in ancient times of the prophets. In Exodus 34: 6-7 our YHWH gives a description of His own character. Both chesed and chen concepts fit within this description. ([Click here for a chart of Thirteen Attributes of YHWH in Exodus 34:6-7](#)) The study of these verses with both English and Hebrew transliterations will be found at this link to our website. When looking at the Hebrew and the form provided, this information indicates twelve aspects of mercy, lovingkindness and covenant love that He has for His people, including forbearance for rebellion, intentional sin and inadvertent sin, and then only one aspect of judgment. It gave me new understanding of the expression that mercy triumphs over justice. When I was shown these things, I could only sit in awe, and wish that such information had been made known to me long ago! It is such a clear foundation for the grace and mercy that Yahshua walked out during His time in the flesh with us, and the judgment in which He will stand when He returns the second time.

The defilement of the world can squeeze the truth that lies in our hearts. We become tired and worn out. On the other hand, the flesh will feed off of the defilement causing more confusion and lack of understanding. Time and time again, we see the example of the Israelis in the *Torah*. They allowed themselves to be led in the wrong direction and everyone *did what was right in his own eyes* (Deut. 12:8; Judg. 17:6; Judg. 21:25). As a result, the nation suffered the consequences (curses) of their actions.

In the Gospel account written by John, Yochanan in the Hebrew, it is noted that:

- The Law came through Moses; grace and truth through Messiah Y'shua. John 1: 17-18

The Greek language is utilized in much of the Brit Chadasha/New Testament although scholarship since the Dead Sea Scrolls were found is now much more clear that many of these books were written in Hebrew first, or at the least, are filled with Hebrewisms and turns of thought. Efforts to

translate these thoughts into Greek without fully comprehending the idioms has been found by some Biblical scholars to be the basis for the awkwardness of the Greek phrases. Previous efforts to understand this resulted in the concept of Koine Greek, or the less well educated use of the language that was suspected to be how the apostles may have written it. This was discovered by a number of people who noticed that the syntax or word order of the Greek flowed naturally back into Hebrew with a minimum of the usual type of struggle that translation involves.

If we put in the Hebraic understanding rather than the English words we are so familiar with it looks like this:

- For the Torah=Righteous Teachings of YHWH came through Mosheh; beauty/charm and truth came through Messiah Yeshua.

Many translations have further obscured this understanding by placing a conjunction between these phrases: but

- For the Law came through Moses; BUT grace and truth came through Christ Jesus.

You will notice that this little word is written in italics, which indicates that it is not in the original language! By adding this conjunction, the impression is given that the Law is somehow inferior to the grace and truth that comes through Messiah; rather than understanding that Messiah demonstrated the fullness of grace, beauty, charm and truth that was/is the essence of our YHWH's righteous teachings, so often called Law. In this way, a faulty understanding that polarized the concepts of grace and law came into being. It was never intended to be so! The righteous teachings came first to show us the standard, and demonstrate that on our own we as human beings really can't reach the standard. Then the beauty, grace and charm of Yahshua's sinless obedient life showed us what Torah Righteousness really looks like, and the coming of His Ruach, writing that Law on our hearts gives us the resource of Himself in whom we live and move and have our being to walk out this grace and love.

When we can clear our hearts and minds of this false dichotomy, or polarization, of the two concepts, we are well on our way to more accurately understand just what this concept of grace really means.

Marcion, one of the "church fathers" in the early days following the Resurrection developed the idea, among others, that the Old Testament God, YHWH, is one of judgment and wrath, while the New Testament God, Jesus/Yahshua, is filled with grace. Though Marcion was removed from his church position because of beliefs such as this, still this concept managed to weave it's way into general thinking and practice then, and remains to this day. In the days of such persecution that people felt compelled to distance themselves from Judaism because Jews were seen as the ones who had killed Messiah, it makes sense that this concept could take hold though it directly contradicts Yahshua's own statements that He and the Father are One; thus He is the Law Giver. It was somehow easier to overlook the fact that the entire Book was written describing Messiah so that we could recognize Him, as He confirmed on the road to Emmaus when He spoke of how all the Law and the Prophets spoke of Himself.
