*the Prophets, EVEN the "righteousness of God" which is through FAITH in Jesus Christ (Messiah) to All and on ALL who believe. For there is no difference.*

*He anxiously desires greatly to embrace me, to scoop me up and hold me, and comfort me but allowing me to realize He and only He was my KEY that I needed to set me free; but allowing me to hit rock bottom so I would come to the end of myself; to hit rock bottom to start over building upon the Rock a new foundation that will last.*

*Yes! he's been there the whole time greatly desiring, anticipating, longing and hopeful that I would reach out and accept the keys of the kingdom and to truly be set free.*

*Today the walls have come down, the bars have been sawed asunder, the wire has been removed and the chains broken. On this day inside prison, I have been set free! They can hold my flesh but can't hold my Spirit and I soar on eagles' wings, set free!*

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We love to sing the song and never fail to get encouragement from this directive to prepare the way and build up the highway of our Elohim. Recently, during our Shabbat study, the question of what the out working of going through the gates has involved in each person's life came up. The different kinds of "stones" that have been barriers to going through the gates were as varied as the people themselves. We began to examine the question of whether these gates indicated our initial coming to faith in Messiah or specifically beginning to pursue Torah; our Living Torah and Messiah. What does it take to be a "builder of the highway?"

A word study and examination of this command is in process. Please join us to add your thoughts and understanding of this directive from the set apart prophet, Isaiah/Yesheyahu. The cost to record this teleconference is about \$50 and would include free long distance call-ins for up to 10 people. 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## Exploring the Meaning of: Go Through the Gates Part 1

***Go through, go through the gates;  
Prepare the way for the people.  
Cast up, cast up the highway;  
gather out the stones;  
lift up a standard for the people.***

Isaiah 62: 10

At a SAM Torah study some weeks ago, we came into discussion of the concept of "going through the gates" (Isaiah 62:10) and what that might actually refer to, beyond just a physical movement. It certainly brings a stirring emotional response and joy as we sing Barry and Batya Siegel's worship music entitled *Go Through the Gates* as it goes on to extend the call to "prepare the way for the people" which we understand as part of our call.

We can see that coming to faith in Messiah by itself, is a kind of coming through the gates of belief, as Messiah is portrayed as a door through which everyone must enter, yet we also observe a similar process occurs as we come into Torah pursuance. Some of our members seem to be making this journey concurrently; coming from a more formal church background and not having been taught how to love Messiah, they are now entering into relationship with Him as well as becoming Torah pursuant. (We hesitate to say Torah observant because we know how very much we have to learn and that there is no way we could "compete" with those who have grown up in Torah. Ah, then what advantage have those of Yehudah . . . )

By definition and straight forward meaning, we intend to examine the main concepts of this verse. In Part One, we will consider the first line and our thoughts.

**Go Through** is Strongs # 5674 *abar*

a primitive root, to cross over, used very widely of any transition, literal or figurative to make go over, to convey over, to order, to deliver.

**the gates** is Strongs # 8179 *sha'ar*

an opening, door or gate, city, port. Plural in the verse and in the song; no indication of capitalization.

Is it more than just coming to faith to "go through the gates"? Is it specifically coming into Torah pursuance? Is building up the highway a specific reference to Torah community and restoration of the ancient paths as we learn and teach others or is it just about coming into faith that there is a Savior Who has made a way for us? We noticed, too, that the song says "for" the people while the KJV says "of" the people.

We all recognize it as a reference to a return to our heritage, Jerusalem, that is a sure and certain hope for our future because YHWH has said so. Beyond this, some thought of the "going through the gates" as entering into the city while others thought of it as a going out.

In typical Hebrew mindset, we see that it is most likely both/and: going in and coming out. Actually physically going to enter the city, or coming out through the gates to welcome others is perhaps the literal meaning.

In a spiritual sense, or *remez*, we perceive the picture of the process of maturing in faith. The development of a mature prayer life is very much like entering the Tabernacle; from the point of entry-the gate-representing Messiah Himself, moving ever closer to the Holy of Holies. It is a going in of developing relationship depth and breadth to our faith.

In the course of going in to the city, we perceive the travelers we may draw along with us as we walk. We envision ourselves as part of the highway of return to the ancient paths of keeping the *moedim* and honoring our Hebrew *Maschiach*, *Y'shua*. Because we walk it out, we show that it can be done today in a YHWH honoring way, if

not perfectly in line with tradition.

There is also the sense of **going back out** "through the gates" to prepare the way, smooth it, be a forger of paths, once we have drawn our strength, discernment and equipping from Messiah. In some ways it seems imperative that we actually have gone in so that we are equipped to look back and encourage those who come after. Yet it is also true, that our obedience to **just go in at all** is a witness to others and is actually being a part of the highway of return itself! What an awesome responsibility He has given us to be alive at this point in time, as the exile ends, the fullness of the gentiles comes in and He provides sanctuary and the return call. (Lev. 26: 44; Ezekiel 11: 16-17)

Review of the Strongs entries for each of the significant words confirms that this "going through the gates" refers to a transition time, both in the literal and figurative sense. There may be an idiomatic sense too, of a provocation to anger in the proclamation to cross over, which we are researching a bit more.

It brings to mind the "crossing over" that was and is required throughout the history of YHWH's called out ones; the unassembled assembly; the *kahal*. As we go through a gate, we are crossing over the line established by the wall. We are either in or out.

Going through the gates represents a determination, a decision not to turn back, but to commit to a new mode of action or course of life.

The use of the term "gates" in plural would seem to confirm the physical sense of the many gates in the wall of the city of Jerusalem, with no apparent intent for it to be viewed in the figurative sense of Messiah being the door or gate, that we perceive. I don't think this makes the perception wrong but perhaps puts it in the category of a *remez*, or spiritual understanding that the Ruach conveyed to us at this time for His purposes.
